The operating income for the year was \$1,664,198 and the net income for the year was \$2,501,186.

Cash up \$727,000 from May. Accounts receivable was down \$215,000 from May. Accounts payable was up \$180,000 from May. Accrued expenses was down \$34,000 from May.
